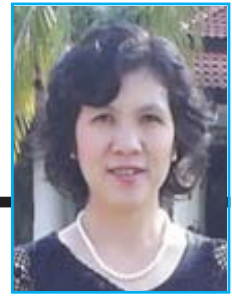
I do believe that with the strong support of our members in addition to our efficient editorial team will certainly make this journal a promising one in this region.
