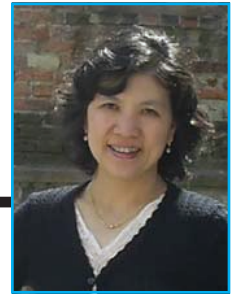


Message from Editor in Chief of Thai Journal of Gastroenterology 2007-2008
